If the cover page under Box 2 on a new, competing continuation, revised, supplemental asks the following:

“Response to Specific Request for Applications or Program Announcements or Solicitation” Yes or No.

If No, then the proposal is considered unsolicited and may be **POSTMARKED** by the receipt date shown in the NIH guide.

If Yes, then the proposal is considered solicited (responding to an RFA, PA, or Solicitation) and must be **RECEIVED** by NIH on the receipt date.
